Dr. Nii Sowa is an economic and investment consultant and also the Ghana Country Director of the LSE Oxford run International Growth Center.

Until recently Dr. Sowa was the Director General of the Securities and Exchange Commission, Ghana. He is an economist by training, with a bias in Money and Banking and Econometrics.

He has lectured at several universities both Ghana and abroad. He was the Head of the Department of Economics from 1988 to 1992. He has also consulted for several reputable institutions and agencies including the World Bank, the United States' USAID, the Canadians' CIDA, the British DFID, and the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa.

He has published extensively in the areas of Money and Banking and Economic Policy Management. In 1997, he was named the First Michael Bruno Fellow to the World Bank. Earlier in 1991, he had won the Best Academic Article Award from the Ghana Academy of Arts and Sciences. He is a member of the Monetary Policy Committee of the Bank of Ghana.
